○ **WELCOME & OLD BUSINESS**

- NJCAA Cross Country Championships - November 12th
 - There have been no public complaints after the event.
 - Largest NJCAA XC Championship in history by 10 teams!
 - Teams were very respectful and volunteers were great.
 - 72 Teams, 316 Women Participants, 304 Men Participants
 - For future large events, we need to work with the Partners more to help notify businesses.
- Holiday Bazaar - November 19th
 - 32 vendors this year (7 more than 2015)
 - Good public turnout overall
 - Some vendors were not pleased that the building had no heat (although they were aware of this before they signed the vendor agreement)
 - Look at ideas on how to heat/cool the building. Commissioner Wilkinson will talk to the Commission about this.

○ **BED TAX NUMBERS**

- Currently the bed tax is at 5% (set in 1980's?). Jen would like to ask the Commission to increase the tax rate to 6%. Most communities in Kansas have an average bed tax rate of 6-7%

- Updated Report shows 2016 numbers are much lower than last year. Mostly because the refinery did not have a turnaround this year. 2015's report was also \$30,000 more than any year before it as well.
