1. Call meeting to order and approval of the minutes from February 4, 2016.

2. Runway 15-33 Rehab project update - Caleb

The project has been designed by Olsson Associates and the FAA has the 90% submittal. Currently we are waiting on the FAA for their comments on the submittal. From there Olsson’s will make the necessary changes. The plan is still to advertise for Bid as soon as that is finished then receive bids hopefully in late April. Construction is tentatively planned for in the fall of 2016. The project includes re-saw and re-seal all joints along with some panel replacement where needed.

3. Runway 4/22 Crack Sealing - Caleb

City crew came out cleaned out the cracks in the asphalt of Runway 4/22 and put new crack sealing materials in where it was needed. This took a week and a half and is intended to help give some extended life by slowing some of the freeze/thaw type of activity.

4. TSA Airport Outreach

The Transportation Safety Administration came for their annual airport visit. Their slogan is “If you see something, Say Something”. If things like suspicious airport tenants are encouraged to tell Caleb unless it’s an emergency type situation then they should call the police, then Caleb. TSA toll free number to call in suspicious activity is 866-GA-SECURE. The rare cases this has been needed in the past the tenants have done a good job but it’s always a good reminder when TSA comes out for their airport visit.
