


How to reduce windrows



We're often asked why snow plow drivers push snow into a driveway after the homeowner has already shoveled the driveway. The reality is that this is unavoidable. The snow pushed on the end of a driveway is called a windrow. Plow drivers push snow to the right while clearing streets. To help reduce the appearance of windrows, pile snow on the left side of your driveway (facing your home), and shovel an inlet on the right side.
