

Trash & Recycle carts must be at curb by 7am the morning of collection & removed within 24 hours.

Excess trash must be in Orange bags. Lids must be closed & cannot be tied down. Make sure they are not blocked or too close to your mail box

WHAT CAN YOU RECYCLE?

Plastic Containers

Plastic containers that have a recycling triangle with a #1 or a #2 on the bottom
Unmarked plastics & any other kind of plastics are NOT accepted in this program.
Please rinse & remove caps before setting out for service.

Glass

Not accepted in Recycle – please put in trash.

Aluminum and steel (tin) cans

Empty & rinse - Labels do not need to be removed. Clean aluminum pie tins are also acceptable.

Paper Goods

Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, chip cardboard (for example cereal boxes, pop cartons, and other like packaging) & office paper as well as corrugated cardboard. Large boxes need to be broken down & placed by the cart.





Welcome to El Dorado,

Please read carefully. The City of El Dorado requires all animals inside city limits to be licensed. Therefore if you own a dog and/or cat, you must obtain a city license as soon as possible. Please remember only 4 animals are allowed per household. Pitbulls require an application to own inside city limits. No farm animals, roosters, geese, ducks, pigs etc., or exotic pets are allowed inside El Dorado City Limits. **Animal licensing periods run from January 1 to December 31 each year.** You must show proof of rabies vaccination & if sterilized when purchasing your animal(s) city license. A \$2 per month penalty for late licensing begins March 1.

Rates for licensing dogs & cats are as follows:

- Each Sterilized dog or cat -- \$ 5.00 per year
- Each Unsterilized dog or cat -- \$40.00 per year

For your convenience, licenses may be purchased at the City of El Dorado Animal Shelter, 222 E. Locust; El Dorado City Hall, 220 E. 1st; El Dorado Animal Clinic, 111 E. Locust; Bluestem Animal Clinic, 830 W 6th, Natural Pet Care Center, 405 Business Circle or Augusta Animal Clinic (A small handling fee may be charged by the veterinary clinics selling the license). You cannot purchase your licenses through the mail.

The City of El Dorado requires all animal owners to:

- Provide rabies vaccinations for all of their animals.
- Purchase current license (s) & keep them on your animal (s).
- Keep your animal (s) confined on your property at all times except to exercise or walk, at which time you must have complete control of the animal. If your animal defecates on any property other than your private property, you must remove it.
- Provide your animal (s) with proper veterinary care, food, water & shelter from the weather.

The dog park located at 321 E. Locust offers a safe environment for you & your dog to get plenty of exercise without the constraints of a leash. Rules are posted on the fence.

We also offer a live trap program for Skunks, opossums, feral cats, etc. You must come to the shelter & sign an Animal Trap Form to allow us to provide this service to you each year. Private trap owners must all sign this form each year. Only live traps are allowed inside city limits.

We encourage you to comply with all municipal licensing & control regulations to prevent complications. We hope you will find our concepts & control programs acceptable. We ask your cooperation in making our city an enjoyable place to live for both pet owners & non-owners.

Should your animal become lost, please call the shelter immediately. If you have any questions or concerns please contact us.
