
# What is Public Works???

The Public Works Department is responsible for a wide variety of activities within the city including maintenance of streets and roads, maintenance and operation of storm water drainage infrastructure, maintenance and janitorial services of public buildings, operation of a central maintenance garage, fleet services, traffic sign and signal maintenance, all solid waste activities including solid waste collection, recycling and composting. Also included in the day to day operations is animal control and sheltering operations, Information Technology and operation of the municipal airport.





# City of El Dorado Captain Wilbur Jackson Thomas Memorial Airport EQA



June 2, 2010 - June 2, 2015



These Flight maps depict actual IFR (Instrument Flight Rules) flights that have come and gone from the airport. IFR flights account for an estimated 5% of the local traffic at the airport. These flight spread from coast to coast. Washington state to Florida, Massachusetts to California.

Where are people that use the airport going?

The answer is: **EVERYWHERE**

- There are currently 43 aircraft that base out of El Dorado/ Captain Jack Thomas Memorial Airport. In 2010 there were approximately 29 airplanes based. Over a 6 year period that is an approximate 48% increase in based aircraft
- There are 25 T hangars and 2 Community Hangar (Multi-Storage)
- 220 acers total airport ground
- Runway 4-22 4204'
- Runway 15-33 4200'
- Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS) commissioned in 2012 providing accurate weather for pilots and community.
- Businesses that base out of the airport (permanent and temporary)
  - Peterson's Performance Plus
  - Aerial Applicators (Spray planes)
  - Flight Training/ Airplane rides
  - Pipeline patrol
- Fuel Sales:
  - Year End 2010 – 21,000 gallons
  - Year End 2013 – 30,800 gallons
  - Year End 2014 – 31,000 gallons
  - Year End 2015 – 31,190 gallons (48.5% increase when compared to 2010)
- On an average day the airport sees between 10 – 15 operations (landings). On the most active days there can be as many as 40 due to the use of the airport for training pilots both by based businesses and other area pilots.
