Rules for Participation

- You must reside within the city limits of El Dorado
- You must live alone, or if you live with another person, that person is unable to render you assistance in an emergency.
- You must be able to call the El Dorado Police Department every day between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m.
- You must notify the El Dorado Police Department if you will be away or unable to call in. (For example: you are going away with relatives for a few days, or you will be gone during the normal check in time for an appointment or a day trip)
- You will provide the police department with a key to your residence. (The key will be kept at the police department in a lock box and will only be used in apparent emergency situations to gain access to your residence)

Participation Agreement

I, the undersigned, agree to the rules of participation in the Project Good Morning as listed above.

I understand that the purpose of the program is to provide me with a sense of security and independence, and that the El Dorado Police Department will not provide taxi or errand services.

I understand that if I do not call, the El Dorado Police Department will dispatch an officer to my residence to check on my wellbeing.

I understand that if I do not answer the door for the officer, and the officer reasonably believes that I may be inside and in need of assistance, the officer will:

- 1) Use my key to enter the residence, or
- 2) If a key has not been provided to the El Dorado Police Department, the officer will use whatever force is necessary to gain entrance into my residence.

I understand that the El Dorado Police Department accepts no responsibility for damages caused in entering my residence under the above stated conditions.

I understand that participation in Project Good Morning is a privilege and the El Dorado Police Department reserves the right to discontinue the service should I abuse the intent of the program.

I understand and agree to all of the terms and conditions set forth in this application.
