**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Vince Haines called the April 24, 2019 Special City Commission meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

**BUDGET GUIDANCE**

City Manager David Dillner provided an update on the previous budget discussion and asked the Commission for direction on the questions.

The City Commission decided not to increase the mill levy for the general fund, but did not eliminate the unfunded positions. The Commission agreed to continue with operation and maintenance in the Stormwater fund and requested project information before the next budget cycle. The Commission agreed that excess sales tax money could go to maintenance projects with a preference for parks and recreation projects. The Commission agreed to use at least \$100,000 for infrastructure projects, but wanted to look at reducing rates before making further decisions.

City Clerk Tabitha Sharp reviewed the applications received for boards and committees.

**REPORTS**

The City Commission discussed the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks show and agreed to keep it at McDonald Stadium after the Broncos game.
